3. Calculators are allowed for all accounting subjects provided they are battery-powered, silent in operation, with neither printouts nor graphic/word display facilities. For other courses, calculators may not be used in the examination except where permission is given in a particular paper. For details, please consult your Course Teacher.
4. Oral examination for Business Putonghua I & II, HKASL Chinese Language, HKASL Use of English, EWP I & II and IELTS (All Levels) are to be conducted during class and completed during Cycle 14.
